Dear Parents,

At Key Biscayne K-8 Center, we build life-long readers by instilling a love of reading in our students. To accomplish this, our students will participate in the **Accelerated Reader (AR) program** designed to motivate students to read at their independent level utilizing a point system. A motivational system will be established in each grade level class to recognize and reward students meeting goal points every grading period. At the end of the school year, students meeting goal points all grading periods will be recognized at the awards assembly.

At the beginning of the school year, all students will be administered the STAR test to provide a report to determine the student's grade equivalent reading level and ZPD range. This measurement (ZPD) provides the **range** from which the students should be selecting books. Students select and read books from an approved AR, comprehensive reading list. Upon completion of the book, students then take a simple, computerized quiz containing objective questions about details from the book. Students are awarded points based on the length and difficulty of the book, as well as how he or she performed on the quiz.

In addition to motivating students to read, Accelerated Reader provides accountability for student reading. Miami Dade's Comprehensive Research-Based Reading Plan requires **all students to read independently for 30 minutes at home** and in class.
